

Bay View Farms Equestrian Day Camp for Girls

2010 Summer Equine Camps

- **June 7-11 Beginner Rider Equine Camp-** for girls ages 6-12 with little to no equine experience. Will be assigned to a horse to learn to care for and ride. Fun riding activities. All-around equine experience.
- **June 14-18 Intermediate Rider Equine Camp-** for girls ages 7-13 years who can walk/trot and are ready to push on to more advanced riding skills. Use camp horses, or bring your own.
- **July 5-9th 9am-1pm Weanlings Camp- Tiny Tots Equine Camp** for ages 4-6 years- 4 day immersion camp for young girls to learn riding and horse care skills at their own pace.

What you need to know!

- Camps fill up quickly! So register as soon as possible. In order to reserve your spot, at least half the payment must be received at time of registration
- Full Payment is due 2 weeks before camp starts.
- Cancellations must be made before start of camp—there is a non refundable cancellation fee of \$50. There is NO refund for those that cancel the week of camp.
- Must have at least 6 campers in order for camp to be held.
- All camps are \$275 for the week
- Camp runs from 9am- 3pm Monday-Friday. Friday afternoon is open for parents to come see what their camper has accomplished as the campers put on a small horse show.
- A confirmation letter and camp schedule will be sent out confirming your spot for a particular camp along with other important info pertaining to that camp.
- Riding Attire:
 - ☞ Helmets ARE REQUIRED. No exceptions. If you may borrow a helmet from the barn for the week for \$5. Helmet cannot leave the facility.
 - ☞ Riding pants, jeans, kakis or breeches are required. No Shorts!
 - ☞ Please try to ride in riding boots/boots with heel. No tennis shoes
- Bring your own lunch and drinks. Extra drinks and snacks will be available throughout the day for campers.
